GABBY GAUDET is the product of a racing family as she is the daughter of longtime trainers Eddie and Linda Gaudet, sister to current trainer Lacey Gaudet and will soon be married to trainer Norm Casse this September. She began her career as an analyst and paddock reporter for the Maryland Jockey Club while still a student at Towson University in 2013. In addition to working at Laurel Park and Pimlico Race Course, Gabby has since covered racing for Arlington Park, the Breeders' Cup, Gulfstream Park and TVG. She joined NYRA for the first time prior to the 2016 summer meet at Saratoga and has continued an expanded role on the Fox Sports 2 and MSG broadcasts. Gabby is also an official member of one of our beneficiaries, the Retired Racehorse Project.

While in college, Gabby was an exercise rider for trainer Tim Keefe, who was a member of the winning team last year in the inaugural Real Rider Cup. Tim's mount last year will be Gabby's mount this year - millionaire Maryland-bred Eighttofastto catch!

"One of the coolest project horses we've had is Streetsofbrooklyn who was retired and turned into a racetrack pony," Gabby said. "He's now with Mark (Casse)'s operation in Florida and is a star. He's ponied horses like Tepin and Classic Empire!"
