JODI MURPHY grew up right down the road from Plantation Field in Unionville, Pa. As a young rider she was active with both Mr. Stewart’s Cheshire Foxhounds and its Pony Club.

After college, Jodi dove right back into life with Thoroughbreds, galloping horses at the track for Grover G. “Bud” Delp. Among her regular mounts for the late trainer were multiple graded stakes winner and successful sire Include, and Sunny Sunrise, also a multiple graded stakes winner who ran until age 9 and earned over \$1.3 million. Jodi is a familiar face to all at Maryland racetracks where she has been ponying for 30+ years.

Jodi underwent double knee replacements in late February and is excited to show “all those people who think they can’t ride after knee replacements that they absolutely can! I’m changing my style and this horse’s style, so it’s all a big change. But it’s a good thing!”

Jodi’s mount, War Fleet, is one of two horses in this competition who competed in last year’s inaugural Real Rider Cup where he was on loan to Sean Clancy. Jodi is being sponsored by the Maryland Racing jockey colony in an effort spearheaded by Sheldon Russell.
